Prospective authors are invited to submit high quality infrastructure descriptions through our pre-built online tools, providing information about the facilities' resources and technologies, types of networks, applications and services, interoperability capabilities, availability, commercial status, usage restrictions and limitations, usage areas and application sectors. Further information includes security services, types of coverage and scale, previous utilizations as well as typical types of utilization. Also information about planned improvements and planned evolution of the infrastructure is highly relevant.
